한림대학교의료원은 세계적 명문 미국 컬럼비아와 코넬의대의 모체병원인 뉴욕프레스비테리안병원(NYPH)과 제7회 한림-컬럼비아-코넬-NYP 국제학술 심포지엄을 개최합니다.

올해 심포지엄의 주제는 "How to Cope with Global Pandemic of Cardiovascular Disease"입니다. 오늘날 고령화 및 생활 양식의 변화에 따라 심혈관 질환 발생이 급증하고 있으며 이는 전 인류의 건강에 심각한 경종을 울리고 있습니다. 다행스럽게도 최근 이 분야는 새로운 치료 기법의 임상적 적용으로 눈부시게 발전하고 있습니다. 이번 심포지엄은 심혈관 질환의 위험인자 및 예방, 급성 심근경색, 심부전의 진단 및 치료에 관한 최신 지견을 더욱 심도 있게 다루는 계기가 될 것입니다. 특히 세계적 석학이신 코넬의대의 안토니오 고토(Antonio M. Gotto) 학장님의 참석과 더불어 컬럼비아의대 심장내과의 앨런 슈워츠(Allan Schwartz) 박사님의 특강도 예정되어 있습니다.
